

Feed gaps

... are expensive to fill with supplements

...can have knock-on effects at other times of the year

... are stressful for animals, people and the land


Forage Chain concept

We can use different types of plants and feeds to create a year round Forage Chain.

Different plants and feeds have different optimum windows for grazing.

The challenge is to link them together over the whole year, avoiding feed gaps.



What is a forage chain?




How does this relate to Soil Health?

 \uparrow ground cover = \downarrow erosion = \uparrow soil health

 \uparrow plants (diversity, productivity, perenniality) = \uparrow soil health



The planning process

- 1. Current forage chain
- 2. Feed gaps
- 3. Poor performing soils
- 4. Forage opportunities
- 5. Future forage chain

Big opportunities

- Confinement / deferral
- Cereals for extra winter "feed"
- Better (3rd gear) pastures for TB ewes
- Quality late spring pastures for lambs
- Turning shit land into something useful
- Turning risky land (e.g. frost prone, sand) into reliable profit
- Better utilisation of chaff, straw, seconds, etc

The end goal – raising the baa

- Higher stocking rate
- Higher animal production
- Less supplementary feed
- Less labour
- Lower cost of production
- Less stress
- More ground cover
- Healthier soil
